

WRITE BESIDE THEM

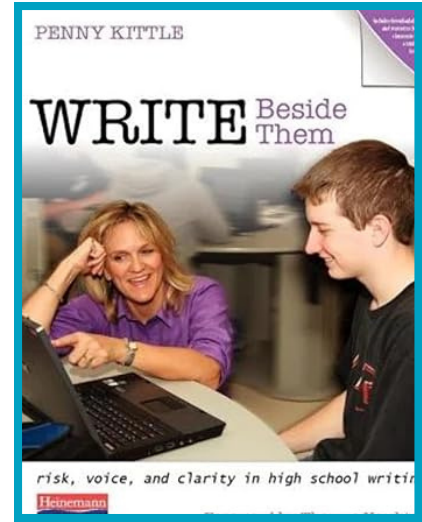
A CUWP WORKSHOP FOR K-12 TEACHERS

Instructors: Craig Jeppson (Wasatch HS) & Regan Gull (Skyridge HS)

This three-credit, one-week intensive course is designed for K-12 teachers of all grade levels and subject areas to learn research-based strategies to cultivate students' ability to write and think successfully.

Taught by experienced teachers who are CUWP Fellows, this professional development week will guide participants to reconnect with their own writing selves while improving their writing teaching practices. Each day, we will spend time writing, working with each other in writing groups, engaging critically with the professional literature, and developing lesson plans that align with the principles and values we discuss together.

Tuition includes a copy of "Write Beside Them: Risk, Voice, and Clarity in High School Writing" (2008) by Penny Kittle and two provided meals during the workshop. The option to enroll in a university credit-bearing course exists for a marginally higher tuition fee.
